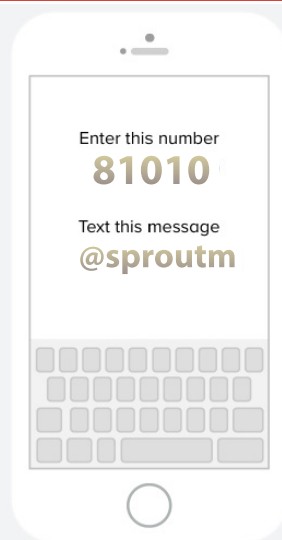


PHOTO SHARE
